The covenantal relationship with God is symbolized by the practice of baptism in any of three modes: sprinkling, pouring, or immersion. The pastor will answer any questions you may have regarding baptism for you or your children.

Christian Education

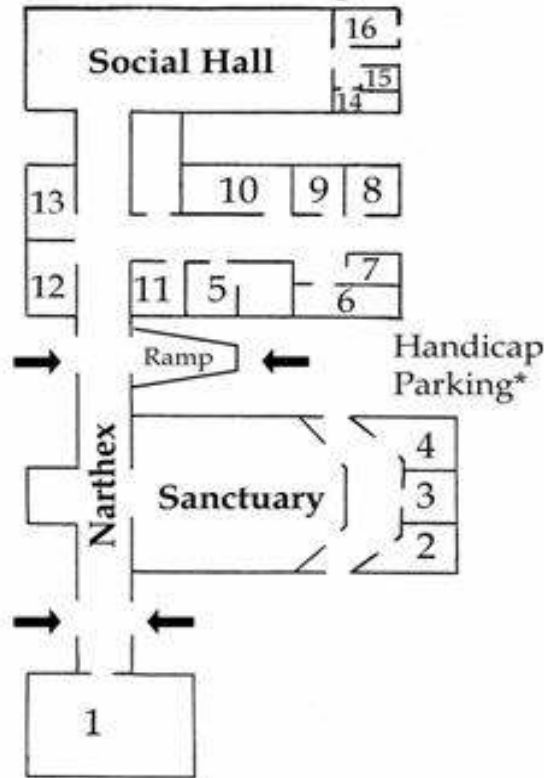
Classes are available for all ages and stages of faith offering opportunities for spiritual growth.

Church Layout

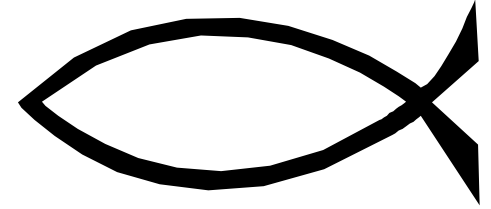


2 – Church Office
